Did you know...?

- Camp Crucis is one of only a few Christian summer camps in the state of Texas that continues the orthodox teachings of the Church.
- Like all diocesan churches, Camp Crucis is a non-profit organization and runs on a balanced budget.
- In addition to summer camp, Camp Crucis also offers trail rides, birthday parties, family reunions, business meetings, retreats, quilting groups, and weekend cabin rentals.
- It has been over 15 years since any major improvements have been made to any camp lodges.
- Each year a large portion of our budget is spent on repairing aging equipment.
- Currently, Camp Crucis cannot host our own diocesan clergy retreat and we have to turn away some larger retreats because we do not have enough retreat-friendly lodging [semi-private rooms with restroom facilities].
- Last year one of the Women's Retreats filled all of the retreat areas and their leaders needed to sleep in the summer camp cabins.
- In August of this year, Camp Crucis has a retreat booked for the International Hispanic Anglican Conference and will have over 225 people from many countries staying at Camp Crucis along with several bishops, including Archbishop Foley Beach of ACNA, and Archbishop Tito Zavala of the Southern Cone. Many of these participants will be staying in the summer camp cabins.
